Learners from Grade 1 to Grade 7 are all involved. Parents are welcome to come and cheer learners on. This event is held during school hours and is compulsory for all learners. It is usually held at Tempe Athletics field from 7:00 till 13:00. Learners must be dropped and fetched at the event.

Valentines Day / Talent Show / Sokkie

Learners from Grade R to Grade 7 dress in pink, red and white for the day. Learners can post letters and small gifts for their friends in the class post boxes. A talent show is held in the morning, learners from Grade 1 can enter a talent show item e.g. poem, song, dance, joke, instrument etc. Small prizes are awarded in each category. Parents are welcome to come watch and support their children. A valentine's sokkie is held in the evening for Grade 4 to Grade 7 learners in the hall from 17:30 till 19:00.

Pet Show

Our annual pet show is held at the school each year to raise funds for animal welfare. Donations are collected at school for animal welfare and they are presented to the organisation at the Pet Show. Learners from Grade R to Grade 7 can enter their pets for the Pet show, which takes place on a Saturday. There are different categories and learners can even enter their stuffed animals.

“Spel en Speel”

An Afrikaans spelling competition that is hosted with Afriforum and Volksblad. Two learners from Grade 4 to Grade 7 are chosen for Home language and Additional language to represent the school. A list of spelling words is given to them to learn. The competition takes place in the morning.

Black Tie & Princess Ball

A ball, which is held for Grade R to Grade 7 girls and their fathers, learners from other schools may also attend. The ball is held as a fundraiser and a part of the funds are donated to a Reach for a dream project. This event usually takes place in March and is a fun filled and glamorous evening for girls and their fathers. The ball is a glamorous evening that girls can dress up in a formal dress and attend with their father.

Term Concerts

Each term a concert is held to share the learners various talents and skills. The following learners are involved in term concerts: choir, drama, dance, pom poms,

eisteddfod items, any learner who takes music lessons. These learners do not perform at every concert, each term learners are informed if they will take part that term or not.

Year end concert

This concert is a huge stage production, which involves all learners from Grade R to Grade 7. It is compulsory for all learners as each learner plays a small part in the production. Grade 4 to Grade 7 learners are assessed on their performance during practices and the show and these marks are used for their fourth term Arts and Culture mark.

Golf day

Eisteddfod

Each year our school takes part in the Eisteddfod in Bloemfontein, one year it is in English and the next year it is in Afrikaans. We try to involve all the learners by encouraging them to at least say a poem at the Eisteddfod; this helps the learners to gain self-confidence and broadens their performance knowledge.

“Dink of Sink” Debate competition

An Afrikaans debate competition that is held with Afriforum and Volksblad. One Junior team of three learners made up of Grade 4 and Grade 5 learners and one Senior team of three learners made up of Grade 6 and Grade 7 learners are chosen to participate in this competition. The learners have to work together to do unprepared debates about different topics.

Class Debate

Debates are held in class context during Home language period from Grade 2 to Grade 7, teachers then select a few learners from each grade to take part in the school debate. Debates are prepared like orals on the given topics for each grade.

School Debate

A few learners from each grade are selected to speak at the school debate. Grade 1 to Grade 7 learners watch the debate as learners present their speeches. Small prizes are awarded to the best debaters in each grade. Parents are welcome to come and watch the debate, which takes place during school time.

Casual day

Each learner buys a casual day sticker in aid of people with disabilities and may then dress up as anything for the day (Fairy, Pirate etc.). A fashion parade is held for all the learners from Grade R to Grade 7. People with disabilities come to talk to the learners to make them aware of different types of disabilities.

Grandparents Day

The Grade R learners invite their grandparents to spend a day at school with them. The learners hold a short concert for their grandparents and then do some arts and crafts with them. They each pack their own picnic basket and have a picnic with their grandchild.

Literature Evening

At least one creative writing piece from each learner from Grade 1 to Grade 7 is selected for our Write Stuff book each year. This book can be ordered, costs will be given before the Literature Evening. At the Literature evening each child may read their piece aloud to the audience. Parents donate children's books to help us grow our school library. This is a lovely evening that encourages learners to write and read more.

Art Exhibition

Our annual art exhibition is held in the fourth term to showcase all the fantastic artworks that learners have made throughout the year. Every grade displays their artworks in their classroom and parents can purchase their children's artworks in order for us to raise money for our art department.

Eduplus Fun Run

This fabulous event takes place every year in October, it is a lovely walk or run in the early evening. Children are given sponsorship forms prior to the run, a child can then be sponsored for each kilometre they walk or run to raise funds for the school. A competition is held between the different grades to see who can raise the most money for the school. Come and join us for a 1km, 5km or 10km walk or run!

Museum Exhibition

This exhibition is for Grade 4 to Grade 7 learners, it is part of their Social Science curriculum and is compulsory. Learners are given a topic and asked to create an exhibition about the topic. Learners are assessed according to their knowledge and presentation of their tasks.

Pom poms

This is an extra mural activity that learners can participate in. A yearly fee of R500 is charged to buy uniforms, pom poms, flags etc. The uniforms remain the property of the school and must be returned at the end of the year.
